will be attending the following excursion:

• Writers Festival Secondary Schools Day located at Riverside Theatre, corner of Market and Church Street, Parramatta on Tuesday, May 4th, 2021

This excursion costs \$25 per student and students must have an OPAL card with at least \$8.00 credit. This will be the cost of their return train ticket.

Students will meet at Leumeah Train Station at 8am and will depart at 8:10am. The group will then catch the train to Parramatta Station. From there we will walk to Riverside Theatre where students will attend the Writers Festival. After the sessions have finished, students will walk from the venue back to Parramatta Train Station where we will catch the train back to Leumeah Train Station. Students will be dismissed from Leumeah Train Station and will be supervised until 3:10pm. It is the responsibility of parents to ensure that children are transported to and from the station. As per the Public Health Order, all students over the age of 12 are required to wear a facemask on public or chartered transport, this includes school buses. Please ensure that your child/ward brings a facemask with them on the day.

The Sydney Writers Festival is an annual event that takes place in Sydney. The Secondary School Days program is a wonderful opportunity for students to listen, investigate and question, alongside some of Australia's leading writers for young adults. Throughout the day, these writers inspire and challenge students through a thoughtful discussion of literature and ideas. The program is designed to grow students' enjoyment of books, writing and reading by providing them with new perspectives, insight into writing processes and encouragement to consider their own creative pursuits.

There will be opportunities for students to purchase books by the presenting authors if they choose. The participating Australian authors for 2021 are Garth Nix, Leanne Hall, Zana Fraillon, and Gary Lonesborough.
